Directions to MPAC – Gaithersburg: 2 choices: 1. 495 Beltway to 270 North to Exit 9A (marked Sam Eig Highway/Metro Stop/Gaithersburg Town Center). As you get off 270 exit, bear right and follow signs to exit Gaithersburg Town Center **355 North**. Go about 1 mile on Route 355. Turn Left at light on S. Summit. MPAC is in back of Ascension Episcopal Church. See MPAC Sign. Make first left into church parking lot, drive to the back of the building where you will see a playground, Walk into playground area.
