Directions to The Arc of Montgomery County: Traveling South on 355 (Rockville Pike). Take 355 to Randolph Rd. (Montrose Rd.) turn Left proceed to the 2nd traffic light, turn Right on Nebel St., follow for almost 1 mile to the Red Brick Building (2 story) turn Right into the parking lot (lower side). Traveling North on 355 Turn Right on Nicholson Lane proceed to the 3rd traffic light, turn LEFT on Nebel St., proceed about 1/10 of a mile to 11600 Nebel St., on the Left turn the parking lot (lower side) Traveling from the East side take Randolph Rd., cross Train tracks, make Left at the light, Nebel St., proceed as above when traveling South on 355.
